B. DISCUSSION ITEM.

1. Discussion and consideration of finding that the following constitute sufficient grounds to establish the need for calling and holding this emergency meeting: on March 13, 2020, the President of the United States declared COVID-19 a national emergency; and on March 15, 2020 the Governor of the State of Oklahoma declared an emergency caused by the impending threat of COVID-19 to the people of this state and the public's peace, health and safety; all 77 of Oklahoma's counties were included in the state of emergency; the State of Emergency Operations Plan has been activated, and resources of all state departments and agencies available to meet the emergency are committed to the reasonable extent necessary to prepare for and respond to COVID-19 and to protect the health and safety of the public within the State of Oklahoma; preventive measures require action by the City as establishments are not voluntarily complying with CDC recommendations.

2. Discussion and consideration of an ordinance amending the Midwest City Municipal Code, Chapter 5, Article I In General, adding 5-1 Emergency operating hours and procedures for food establishments and providing for repealer, severability and declaring an emergency.

2a. Discussion and consideration approving the Emergency Clause.
