

1 **ELECTION PROCLAMATION**

2
3 Pursuant to Resolution No. 2023- 10, duly adopted by the governing body of the City of Mid-
4 west City, Oklahoma, the Mayor of the City of Midwest City, for the purpose of an election to
5 amend City of Midwest City Ordinance, Chapter 40, Taxation; Article II, Sales; Section 40-44,
6 Limited-Purpose Tax; Sales Subject to Tax; Fifty-Five Hundreds (0.55) of One Percent (1%),
7 hereby calls in the City of Midwest City, County of Oklahoma, State of Oklahoma:

8 **PROPOSITION**

9 Shall Ordinance No. 3514 be approved, amending the City Code of Midwest City,
10 Chapter 40, Taxation, Article II, Sales Tax; Section 40-44 (a)(1), Limited-purpose tax;
11 sales subject to tax:

12 Seventy-three (73) percent or four thousand fifteen ten thousandths (.4015) of one (1)
13 percent of the additional excise tax levied pursuant to this section shall be expended
14 and used for the following purposes and in the following manner:

15 a. Four-fifths or eighty percent (80%) shall be expended and used to pay for capital
16 improvement projects for the City. As used in this section, the term “capital improve-
17 ment project” shall mean a project for the construction of new, repairs or improve-
18 ments to existing drainage/stormwater conveyances; improvement or repairs to roads
19 and/or bridges; the construction and/or maintenance of trails; repair, improvements,
20 and/or replacement to the wastewater resource and recovery facility and/or water
21 treatment plant; improvements or repairs to raw water lines; or construction of new,
22 improvements to or repairs to either the water distribution lines, or the wastewater
23 collection lines; and for any personnel requirements and/or consulting or supporting
24 contracts thereto.

25 b. One-fifth or twenty percent (20%) shall be expended and used to pay for the con-
26 struction of new, improvement or repair to, or operation of all current and future city
27 parks, and for any personnel requirements and/or consulting or supporting contracts
28 thereto.

29 The polling places for the election, if held, shall be opened at 7:00 o’clock a.m. and shall remain
30 open until and be closed at 7:00 o’clock p.m. on September 12, 2023.

31 Pursuant to Title 26 of the Oklahoma Statutes, Section 13-103(c), all precincts totally or partially
32 contained within the limits of the City of Midwest City shall be open for election, except the City
33 authorizes Precinct 244 to be closed. Precinct 244 is only partially contained within the limits and
34 no registered voters reside within that portion.

35 Be it further resolved that the City of Midwest City, through the adoption of Ordinance 1872, has
provided for absentee ballots to be cast in the City of Midwest City’s municipal elections.

All registered qualified electors residing within the boundaries of Midwest City shall be entitled
to vote for the amendment.
