4 b. One-fifth or twenty percent (20%) shall be expended and used to pay for the
5 construction of new, improvement or repair to, or operation of all current and future
6 city parks, and for any personnel requirements and/or consulting or supporting
7 contracts thereto.

10 (2) Nine (9) percent or four hundred ninety-five ten thousandths (.0495) of one (1)
11 percent of the additional excise tax levied pursuant to this section shall solely and only be used
12 for the following purposes and in the following manner as approved by the city council:

13
14 a. Three-quarters or seventy-five (75) percent shall be deposited into the fire
15 department fund capital outlay account, and shall be spent and expended only for capital
16 outlay items and projects necessary or appropriate for the fire department.

18 b. One-quarter or twenty-five (25) percent shall be deposited into the police
19 department fund capital outlay account, and shall be spent and expended only for capital
20 outlay items and projects necessary or appropriate for the police department.

22 (3) Nine (9) percent or four hundred ninety-five ten thousandths (.0495) of one (1)
23 percent of the additional excise tax levied pursuant to this section shall be deposited into the
24 streets fund, and shall be spent and expended only for streets, parks, trails/sidewalks and public
25 transportation as approved by the city council.

27 (4) Nine (9) percent or four hundred ninety-five ten thousandths (.0495) of one (1)
28 percent of the additional excise tax levied pursuant to this section shall be deposited into the
29 general government capital outlay and operations fund, which shall be established as a separate
30 operating fund, and which shall be spent and expended only for capital outlay and projects, and
31 general operating needs of the general fund departments such as, but not limited to,
32 neighborhood services, parks and recreation, city manager, finance, information technology,
33 human resources, community development, city attorney, city clerk and general government, as
34 approved by the city council.

36 (b) For purposes of this section, "capital outlay" shall include, but not be limited to, the
37 purchase or acquisition of machinery, vehicles, equipment, furniture, interests in land, buildings
38 and improvements other than buildings, and construction, reconstruction or improvements to
39 real property. Monies in the limited-purpose tax funds described in subsections (a)(1) through
40 (a)(4) of this section shall be accumulated from year to year and shall be placed in an insured
41 interest-bearing account and the interest that accrues on the fund shall be retained in that fund.
42 The limited-purpose tax funds shall be nonfiscal and shall not be considered in computing any
43 levy when the city makes its estimate to the excise board for needed appropriations. Money in
44 the limited-purpose tax funds shall be expended only for the limited purposes described in the
45 respective subsections (a)(1) through (a)(4) of this section, for that fund. Monies in the limited-
46 purpose tax funds may be appropriated only for the purposes provided by law.

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Section 2. REPEALER. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3. SEVERABILITY. If any section, sentence, clause, or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of the ordinance.
