

ORDINANCE NO. 3538

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING MIDWEST CITY CODE, CHAPTER 24, MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, ARTICLE III, SECTION 24-60, MANUAL AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR TRAFFIC-CONTROL DEVICES; AND PROVIDING FOR REPEALER AND SEVERABILITY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIDWEST CITY, OKLAHOMA:

ORDINANCE

SECTION 1. That Midwest City Code, Chapter 24, Motor Vehicles and Traffic, Article III, Section 24-60, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 24-60. - Manual and specifications for traffic-control devices.

All traffic-control signs, signals and devices shall conform to the manual and specifications approved by the Oklahoma Department of Transportation. All signs and signals required hereunder for a particular purpose shall, so far as practicable, be uniform as to type and location throughout the city. All traffic-control devices so erected and not inconsistent with the provisions of state law or this chapter shall be official traffic-control devices except that part time stop signs may be alternated with children crossing signs for use at school zone intersections provided that the other leg of a three-way intersection or the other two (2) legs of a four-way intersection are fully controlled by stop signs.

SECTION 3. REPEALER. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY. If any section, sentence, clause or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the ordinance.
