Section 38-21. Replat

Sec. 38-21.1. Purpose & Applicability

A <u>Replat</u> of all or a portion of a recorded <u>Plat</u> may be approved without vacation of the recorded <u>Plat</u>, if the <u>Replat</u> meets the following criteria:

(A) Replat Criteria

- (1) The Replat is signed and acknowledged by the owners of the property being replatted; and
- (2) The **Replat** does not propose to amend or remove any covenants or restrictions previously incorporated in the recorded plat.

Sec. 38-21.2. Partial Replat Application

If a <u>Replat</u> is submitted for only a portion of a previously platted <u>Subdivision</u>, the <u>Replat</u> must reference the previous <u>Subdivision</u> name and recording information, and must state on the <u>Replat</u> specific lots that are being changed along with a detailed "Purpose for <u>Replat</u>" statement.

Sec. 38-21.3. Construction Management

(A) Requires Construction

If the <u>Subdivision</u> as replatted requires construction of additional improvements, the provisions of <u>Article</u> <u>IV Construction Plans and Procedures</u> shall apply.

(B) Does Not Require Construction

If the <u>Subdivision</u> as replatted does not require any appreciable alteration or improvement of utility installations, streets, alleys, building setback lines, etc., then no <u>Construction Plans</u> shall be required.

Sec. 38-21.4. Review and Approval Process

(A) Review Action and Approval Action - Same as Final Plat

The review and approval processes for a **Replat** shall be the same as the review and approval processes for a **Final Plat** per **Section 38-19**.

(B) Responsible Official

The <u>Director of Community Development</u> shall be the <u>Responsible Official</u>.

Sec. 38-21.5. Procedures for Recordation Following Approval

The procedures for recordation of a <u>Replat</u> shall be the same as the procedures for recordation of a <u>Final Plat</u>, as outlined in <u>Sec. 38-19.10</u>. <u>Procedures for Final Plat Recordation upon Approval</u>.

Sec. 38-21.6. *Effect*

Upon approval and recording of the **Replat**, it is controlling over the previously recorded **Plat** for the portion replatted.
