Notice of Termination (NOT) for Stormwater Discharges Associated with INDUSTRIAL, CONSTRUCTION OR LAND DISTURBING ACTIVITY

Submission of this Notice of Termination constitutes notice that the party identified in Section I of this form wishes to terminate their authorization to discharge stormwater associated with industrial, construction, or land disturbing activities under a City of Midwest City Stormwater Quality Management Permit.

III. CERTIFICATION:

"I certify under penalty of law that all stormwater discharges associated with industrial, construction or land disturbing activities from the identified facility or site that is authorized by a City of Midwest City Stormwater Quality Management Permit have been eliminated or that I am no longer the owner or operator of the facility or site. I understand that by submitting this notice of termination, I am requesting a final inspection to be performed at the facility or site. I understand that I will continue to be authorized under this permit until the facility or site has passed a final inspection. I also understand that after passing the final inspection I will no longer be authorized to discharge stormwater associated with industrial, construction, or land disturbing activities under this permit, and that discharging pollutants in stormwater associated with industrial, construction, or land disturbing activities to waters of the State is unlawful under Midwest City, ODEQ, and EPA regulations where the discharge is not authorized by a permit. I also understand that the submittal of this notice of termination does not release an operator from liability for any violations of this permit or Midwest City Stormwater Quality Management rules and regulations."

Instructions -- MWC Stormwater Quality Management Notice of Termination (NOT) for Stormwater Discharges Associated with Industrial, Construction, or Land Disturbing Activities

When to File NOT Form:

Permittees who are presently covered under an issued Midwest City Stormwater Quality Management permit for stormwater discharges associated with industrial activity may submit a Notice of Termination (NOT) form when their facilities no longer have storm water discharges associated with industrial activity as defined in the stormwater regulations at 40 CFR 122.26(b)(14), or when they are no longer the operator of the facilities. For a construction site or land disturbing site when the site has been finally stabilized (i.e., a uniform perennial vegetative cover with a density of at least 70% of the native background cover has been established for all unpaved areas and areas not covered by permanent structures or where equivalent permanent stabilization measures such as riprap or gabions have been used), and all discharges from construction or land disturbing activities that are authorized by a Midwest City Stormwater Quality Management permit are eliminated, or they are no longer the operator of facility or site. Section I. Facility Operator Information:

Give the legal name of the person, firm, public organization or any other entity that operates the facility or site described in this application. The name of the operator may or may not be the same name as the facility. The operator of the facility is the legal entity that controls the facility's operation, rather than the plant or site manager.

Section II. Facility/Site Location Information:

Enter the facility's or site's official or legal name and street address.

Enter the existing Midwest City Stormwater Quality Management permit number assigned to the facility or site identified in Section I.

Check the box showing whether you are requesting termination of your permit or the facility is or has changed owner or operator. If changing owner/operator please give the contact information for the new owner/operator.

Section III. Certification:

The NOT form must be signed by a responsible party as follows:

For a Corporation: by a responsible officer, which means; (1) president, secretary, treasurer, or vice president of the corporation in charge of a principal business function; (2) the manager of one or more manufacturing, production, or operating facilities employing 250 persons or having a gross annual sales or expenditures exceeding \$25 million (in second-quarter 1980 dollars) if authority to sign documents has been assigned or delegated to the manager in accordance with corporate procedures.

For a partnership or sole proprietorship: by a general partner or the proprietor.

For a municipality, state, Federal, or other public facility: by either principal executive officer or ranking elected official.
