What Services Do You Provide?

The Household Hazardous Waste Program is made possible by local Stormwater fees already included in residents' utility bills. This allows any resident of MWC, or other cooperating municipality (see next section), to safely dispose of unwanted or expired hazardous products by simply making an appointment and bringing a current utility bill or driver's license. This program not only protects the local water supply, but also keeps our sanitation workers safe from exposure to dangerous or toxic substances.

In addition to providing recycling and disposal services of household hazardous waste, the facility also offers an extensive re-use program. If any products brought to the facility are in good, usable condition, the items are placed out in the re-use shop for anyone to make use of for free. All items taken from the re-use program must be for personal or nonprofit use and cannot be sold. Please call us at #405-739-1049 to set up an appointment today!

Metal, Tires, Electronics, Bulk Items

Metal, Tire, Electronic Recycling: (#739-1049) Recycling is open Wednesday from 8-11:30 & 12:30-3, and Friday from 8-11:30. Items accepted include refrigerators, window air conditioners, washing machines, dryers, electronics, tools, bikes, metal sheet fencing, etc. A current Midwest City water bill must be provided to the attendant on duty. The metal and tire recycling area is located at 8726 SE 15th St. at the Hazardous Waste Facility on the South end of the Charles Johnson Building. Chain linked fencing and barbed wire not accepted.

Bulk Items: Curbside pickups are scheduled for each resident 4 times per year. Please Visit the City of Midwest City's web-page to find out your scheduled bulk pickup weeks. Please be advised that **NO** hazardous items, appliances, construction materials, medical waste, tires or electronics will be picked up at the curb.

Computer Nation/Recycling Central: 232-0211, Open M-F, 9- 4, 1535 W Reno Ave, OKC 73106 (\$.90/lb. for TVs, \$8-10 for computer monitors)
May give credit for some electronics to offset cost

Best Buy: 733-4289/ \$29.99 per TV (Tube TV under 32", Flat Panel under 50")
-Also takes printer cartridges for free

Appliances & Batteries

Metal Check: 636-1916, 5700 S High Ave, OKC 73129 (Takes metal except chain link fencing & barbed wire) Hours: M-F from 8-4pm

Advantage Battery: 612 N Rockwell Ave, OKC 73127/ 787-0033- Lithium, Rechargeable, Lithium Ion, & Lead Acid Batteries; gives credit only for Lead Acid Batteries (may have fee for other types)

Drugs & Needles

Sharps Container: Call the Sanitation/Recycling department at 739-1066 to order sharps containers for the safe storage of needles and syringes.

Prescription Drugs: Local participating Walgreens, CVS, Wal-Mart, and other pharmacies. Also, the Oklahoma County Sheriff's Office at 8029 SE 29th St. will accept prescription medications.

Compost & Green Waste

The City's Water Resources Recovery Facility at 7420 NE 36th street has compost & wood chips for sale. Compost is \$30 per yard plus tax; it can also be delivered within a 25 mile radius for \$275. The compost is available Mon-Fri from 8am to 3pm. Wood chips are free when available, but the patron must load them and a tarp is recommended to keep the compost from blowing during transportation, as it is very light. Please call 739-1533 or 889-1329 before coming to purchase.

Unwanted items such as grass clippings, leaves, woody material, brush, and other forms of green waste can also be disposed of at this facility with an active MWC Utility Bill and Driver's License present. The Compost Facility is open for drop-offs on Tuesdays, Thursdays, & Saturdays between 8:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. No appointment is necessary. For more information call #739-1533 or 889-1329.
